Full	£205	£80	Full access to all our shooting areas once you have passed an interview and wildfowl identification test.	The joining fee of £80 is reduced to £70 if you agree to receive club information via email.
Associate	£80	£80	A non shooting member of the club that allows you to buy a set number of day tickets to shoot on some areas of club land, once you have passed an interview and wildfowl identification test.	The joining fee of £80 is reduced to £70 if you agree to receive club information via email.
Student	£80	No Joining Fee	Full access to all our shooting areas once you have passed an interview and wildfowl identification test, for people in full time education over the age of 18.	Proof of status as a student is required, such as a photocopy of a student card with your photo on it.
Junior	£35	No Joining Fee	Full access to all our shooting areas once you have passed an interview and wildfowl identification test, for people under the age of 18.	Junior members must be accompanied at all times when on club land by someone over the age of 18, proof of age is also required.

The application form has a total of 26 questions which must be answered to the best of the applicant's ability; the example below will explain how to fill out the form correctly:
